

Memorial Day Monday, May 27, 2024, at 11:00 am.

The 3rd Annual Middletown Memorial Day Ceremony will be held at the Memorial Park Flag Court at the intersection of South Church Street and Franklin Street. This is a solemn Ceremony to commemorate the Service of 38 Soldiers, Sailors and Airmen from Middletown who died during the conflicts of the 20th Century. Our Ceremony includes a short concert of Patriotic and Remembrance music by the Rohrersville Band, Presentation of the Colors and three volley rifle salute by the **Boonsboro American Legion Honor Guard, Town Officials** reading the 38 names, laying wreaths at the Monuments and the playing of Taps. Each year, we select two of the 38 Fallen Heroes to Honor with details of their Family Life and Service. For 2024 we will be featuring the stories of Private Edward L. Fulmer Jr., 502 PIR, 101st Airborne, KIA Battle of Carentan and Private Charles Austin Brandenburg, 8th Cavalry Division, KIA Korea. The Town of Middletown with support from AMVETS Post 9 and Sons of AMVETS-Squadron 9, are joining in this effort to ensure that the Ultimate Sacrifices made by these 38 Fallen Heroes will not be forgotten. We are asking for a large turnout of Post 9/Sons/Auxiliary members to attend this event to honor and remember our Fallen Brothers in Arms.



Ladies Auxiliary \$1,500 Scholarship

Applications for the Ladies Auxiliary Scholarship is available from Amvets Post 9 and the guidance department at Middletown High School. The deadline for submission is March 5, 2024. Rule Enforcement
